



~Traveling North: on Rte.16, turn left after the “Welcome to Mount Washington Valley” sign onto Bald Hill Road. Go up the hill 1 mile, on your left you will see the TMCC West Oxford Society (Fryeburg Fair) Barn, the parking area to the Nature Learning Center is immediately after on your left.

~Traveling South: take Rt 16 through Conway Village, go over the train tracks as you leave the town, go through the next set of lights, take your second right onto Bald Hill Rd. Go up the hill 1 mile,

~Traveling East: Take Rt 112 (The Kancamagus Scenic Highway which begins in Lincoln), travel the entire road- approx. 33.75 miles, turn right onto Rt 16 at the intersection, take your second right onto Bald Hill Rd., Go up the hill 1 mile, and turn right at the Inn’s sign onto Chase Hill Rd. and go one more mile to the inn.
